The Organ Committee has been hard at work, and we are excited to share with you a brief update. We have had the opportunity to visit a couple of local area churches to hear their organs, and after extensive research, our committee recommended to Session that (1) we do need a new organ, and (2) that our new PPC organ be a Viscount brand digital organ. Session has approved both recommendations. We have been working with the Viscount dealer to finalize the organ specifications and will be working closely with the Property Committee to finalize any changes within the sanctuary that may need to be made, as our new organ will be situated in the front of the church instead of in the balcony. We are very excited for this overdue instrumental upgrade and the musical opportunities having a new organ will provide, and

we look forward to sharing additional details with you all as soon as they are available.
